



ABOUT THE PROJECT

Women Who Build-Artists Who Own is a project about building women powered networks while building the skills necessary to tackle construction projects. Phase one runs from October 2016 to October 2017. During this phase, women are working together to build new skills, fundraise, marketing, source materials, budget management and ultimately build a tiny house.

After the tiny house is built, it will travel the 5 boroughs teaching construction skills, discussing innovative strategies around higher rents, and different ways to empower community.

TIMELINE

October - May Monthly meetings focused on design, marketing, community outreach, fundraising, budgeting, and skill-building. Two

skill-building sessions each month focused on learning how to measure wood, use saws and roofing nail guns,

flashing, and construction.

June - July Build tiny house at the Knockdown Center in Maspeth, Queens.

August - October Tiny house will travel across NYC and serve as mobile educational and community space.
