Skill-building Team

About:

The Skill-Building group's main goal is to teach skills that will be necessary in the production of the tiny house build to the participants. If the group does not possess some of the skills required, it is the group's responsibility to either learn those skills or find someone who can teach those skills to the participants. The members are also responsible for managing the monthly skill-building meetings.

Goals for the next meeting:

These skills could include using power tools, installing roofing, installing plumbing, or anything else that could be used to build a tiny house.
