About: The documentary team is responsible for documenting the project life cycle including what is said at meetings, short interview questions of (who), and (why) they are participating in the project. Also, documenting skill building classes, and of the general build of the tiny house project.

General Meeting #3: The documenting group took headshots and videos that asked participants who they are and what they are looking to learn from the project. We came up with ideas of producing a 20 min video to tell the story of the project from the beginning to the end. Also we created a plan on promoting Facebook live videos during our workshops to create more exposure.

## FAQ

Q: Do you need your own equipment?

A:Yes and no. It's your choice of bringing your own professional equipment. However, you are liable if your equipment breaks or gets lost. If you have a cellphone that takes pictures and records that would be useful as well. We can use it to record for social media and capture pictures for the events.
